The data presented in each category below is representative of the participants that have been discharged from the Recovery Court. The participant would have needed to have the outcomes data fields completed at admission and discharge to be counted.

Employment Outcomes:

Assessment of Outcome:	Court Outcome:	Statewide Average:	Interpretation:
Positive:	91%	32%	Participant gained or maintained full or part-time employment between admission and discharge.
Unchanged:	9%	3%	Participant's employment status was unemployed or the same between admission and discharge.
Negative:	0%	4%	Participant was incarcerated or unable to work.
Neutral	0%	10%	Discharge status was no in the labor force (e.g., disabled, homemaker, etc.)

Living Arrangement:

Positive	73%	34%	Participant improved or maintained their independent living situation between admission and discharge.
Unchanged	18%	1%	Participant living arrangement was the same between admission and discharge.
Negative	0%	11%	Participant absconded or was in jail, prison, detention facility at the time of discharge.

Improved Education	0%	2%	Participant improved their education status between admission and discharge.
